# Major Works

## Major changes on Coronation Drive 1 November 2009 to March 2010

Brisbane City Council advises that there will be major traffic changes on Coronation Drive – between Cribb Street and Merivale Rail Bridge – from Sunday 1 November 2009.

Traffic changes are essential to complete the final section of the Coronation Drive overpass. Once complete at the end of February 2010, traffic will travel from Riverside Expressway to Coronation Drive, bypassing the Coronation Drive/Hale Street traffic light intersection.

From 1 November 2009 the major traffic changes are:

- 1. Outbound – Coronation Drive** – traffic travelling through to Coronation Drive from Riverside Expressway will now use lanes on the right-hand or northern side of Boomerang Street overpass.
- 2. Outbound – Boomerang Street overpass** – traffic taking the Boomerang Street overpass from Riverside Expressway towards the ICB, will now need to be in the left-hand or riverside lane to access the overpass.
- 3. Inbound** – traffic will be reduced to two lanes between Cribb Street and the Merivale Rail Bridge.

Motorists are advised to follow the signs and take care when driving through the changed traffic conditions. Speed limits will be reduced to 40km/h through the affected area.

During overpass construction motorists are advised to allow more time for their journey and consider alternatives, either taking a different route, travelling outside peak times or using public or active transport options. The Bicentennial Bikeway will be open at all times.

Traffic changes are timed to coincide with the quietest time for Brisbane's roads – during school and university holidays. To ensure works are limited to four months, works will occur day and night.

Brisbane City Council will continuously monitor traffic flows and adjust traffic lights where possible to improve traffic flow. CCTV cameras, emergency response towing vehicles in the area and the Brisbane Metropolitan Traffic Management Centre will monitor and respond to traffic issues.

Hale Street Link will now be known as Go Between Bridge following the announcement of the new name in October 2009.

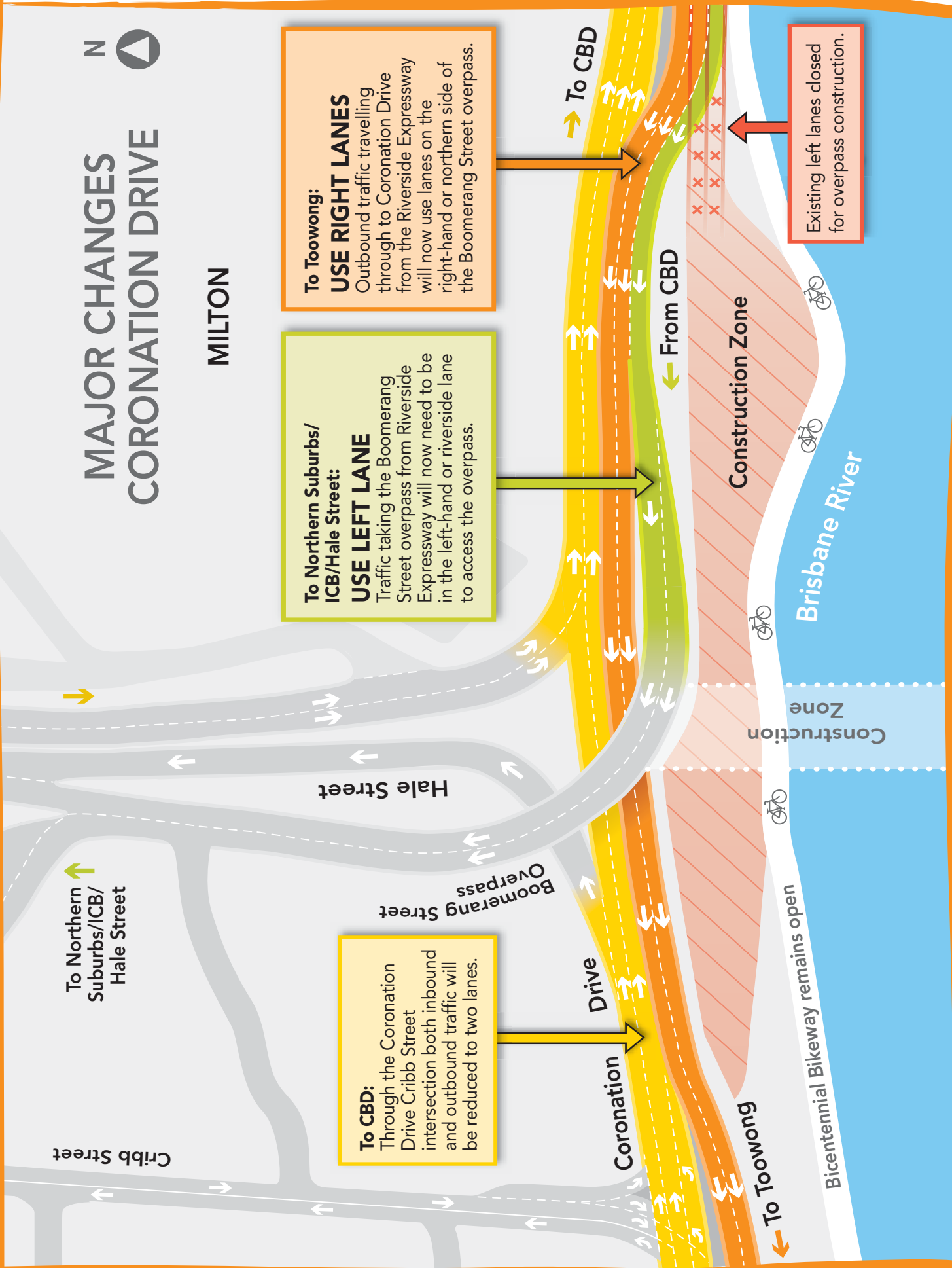
**Go Between Bridge:** Outbound traffic uses the completed Coronation Drive overpass in this artist's impression.

**To Toowoong:**  
**USE RIGHT LANES**  
Outbound traffic travelling through to Coronation Drive from the Riverside Expressway will now use lanes on the right-hand or northern side of the Boomerang Street overpass.

**To Northern Suburbs/ICB/Hale Street:**  
**USE LEFT LANE**  
Traffic taking the Boomerang Street overpass from Riverside Expressway will now need to be in the left-hand or riverside lane to access the overpass.

**To CBD:**  
Through the Coronation Drive Cribb Street intersection both inbound and outbound traffic will be reduced to two lanes.
